Developed to make splitting wood as easy as possible, with maximum durability.

Perfection, every step of the way

The materials that go into creating these extraordinary tools are the secret to their quality. After careful analysis by a master blacksmith, the most suitable material for each tool is selected. And as with the majority of first-class products: the workmanship is carried out by hand.



Forging

The blade and bit are crafted using a free-form forging technique under a spring hammer. The advantage: the piece can be executed more thinly and finely. This makes it lighter, more manageable and more resistant to wear.



Grinding

The tools are gently ground by hand on a water-cooled corundum brick. The hardness of the material is preserved while the quality of the rounded edge and the wear resistance are guaranteed.



Handles

Exquisite handcrafting ensures an optimally even handle. We use only the finest slow-grown mountain ash wood as a material. This is easily recognisable in the densely spaced growth rings and exceptional stability.



Processing

The handle receives a brand with the STIHL logo before being double-waxed. The head of the tool is embossed with the date "1926" as well as its own individual number. Finally the beautiful work of craftsmanship is finished. Each piece is truly one of a kind.
